The *Super Soccer Camp* staff welcomes you to the campus of Ohio Wesleyan University. We hope you will take full advantage of our program and facilities. To assist you during your stay on campus, we have compiled the following guidelines. Please take a moment to read this information.

While you are at camp, we will insist that you do not leave the campus at any time. Our guidelines are flexible, **but this is one rule that will be rigidly enforced**. Also, we must ask that you not wander around campus unescorted. If the situation arises that you must leave campus, please see Jay Martin or Brendan Kronewetter.

Ohio Wesleyan University has prepared all the fields and facilities for your enjoyment. We all must use them safely and properly. In addition to the fields, accommodations for viewing video tapes will be available.

**General Rules and Dormitory Rules:**

1. No smoking
2. No foul language and no noise after lights out which is at 10:30pm.
3. Keep your room clean & locked at all times...***you are responsible for everything that happens in your room!***
4. No rough housing in the rooms or hallways. You will be charged for all damage!
5. Report all injuries to a staff member immediately.
6. Do not wear cleated soccer shoes in dormitory.
7. ***Do not change rooms***
9. Campers who drive must turn in their car keys to Jay Martin each day before the start of camp!

**On the Field Guidelines:**

1. You are responsible to supply a ball at each session. Balls will be sold at camp if you need one.
2. When the session is finished, **you** must find your ball put it in your bag.
3. Our philosophy of "painting the picture" is important. To get the most out of the camp...you must pay attention and participate in each exercise.
4. Make sure you ask any and all questions when you do not understand something.
5. Bring proper clothing (rain jacket, training top) so you are prepared for all weather conditions.

**Other Helpful Hints and Suggestions:**

1. There will be a certified athletic trainer at each session. Report an injury immediately.
2. Parents, before leaving campus, get the extension/telephone number from your campers room.
3. We will honor as many roommate requests as possible. If there is a problem, let Jay Martin or Brendan Kronewetter know on Sunday. We will make every attempt to rectify the situation.
4. The closing ceremony will be held on Thursday night around 8:00 PM at Roy Rike Field. All campers will be dismissed from Roy Rike after the ceremony. All belongings will be removed from Smith Hall after lunch and stored (in a locked room) at Roy Rike.
